DOCTOR OF PHILOSOPHY (PhD) IN EDUCATION AND MASTER OF PHILOSOPHY (MPhil) IN EDUCATION CALLING FOR APPLICATIONS FOR THE ACADEMIC YEAR 2021/2022

Applications for the Doctor of Philosophy in Education and Degree of Master of Philosophy (MPhil) in Education will be entertained from 14/02/2021 to 14/03/2021. These programmes will be only conducted in the Faculty of Education at the main campus in Nawala.

Medium of Study - These programmes are offered in three media: English, Sinhala and Tamil.

General Admission Requirements

Doctor of Philosophy in Education

A candidate should have one of following

- 1. A Master of Philosophy Degree in the field of Education
- 2. A Master's degree in the field of Education at SLQF 9 or above preferably in the field of Education with a significant research component
- 3. A Bachelor's Honours Degree of Level 6 in the field of Education with a minimum GPA of 3.00
- on the scale 0-4 or Second Class (Lower Division). 4. An equivalent or higher qualification acceptable
- to the Senate. And
- 5. Other specific requirements stipulated by the Faculty of Education.

Master of Philosophy in Education

- The candidate should have one of the following qualifications:
- Framework (SLOF) Level 7 or above in the field of education, 2. A Bachelor's Honours Degree at Sri Lanka Qualification Framework (SLQF) Level 6

with a minimum of thirty (30) course credits

1. A qualification of Sri Lanka Qualification

3. An equivalent or higher qualification acceptable to the Senate. And

in the field of education.

Other specific requirements stipulated by the Faculty of Education.

Specific Admission Requirements of the Faculty of Education

- Candidates who do not possess a Post Graduate qualification in Education of SLOF 9 or above will be considered after a selection process.
- All Candidates should successfully complete the short course in Research Methodology in Education conducted by the Faculty of Education (except those who possess two years Master with a research component of 18 course credits) prior to registration of the programme.

Selection Procedure

- 1. Candidates should submit a duly filled application form along with copies of birth certificate, National Identity card and highest academic qualifications and
- 2. Copy of certificate of successful completion of a short course in Research methodology in Education.
- 3. Submit a comprehensive research proposal according to the format given in the Faculty website.
