## DURATION AND COURSE FEE



A substantial subsidized fee which can be paid in three installments as follows

- \* Rs.15,000 at Registration
- Rs.10,000 at the end of first three months
- Rs.10,000 prior to the final evaluation at the end of 06 months

- Only shortlisted candidates will be contacted for an interview.
- Selected candidates are expected to begin the course by mid-January 2022 & Classes will be held on Saturdays and Sundays at the BCIS in Colombo.
- A scholarship scheme is available for specially identified persons.
