The Postgraduate Institute of Indigenous Medicine, University of Colombo will entertain applications from suitably qualified persons for the following Posts up to **26.03.2021**.

A. ASSISTANT LIBRARIAN

Qualifications:

- (i) A First or a Second Class (Upper Division) in a Special Degree,
OR
(ii) A Second Class (Lower Division) in a Special Degree or a First or a Second Class (Upper Division) in a General Degree,
OR
(iii) A Pass in a Degree Examination and a Postgraduate Degree of at least 02 academic years duration in the field of Library and Information Sciences with a research component by way of thesis/dissertation

Notes:

- (a) An applicant who is eligible under (iii) above could be considered for appointment only if no applicant/s qualified under (i) or (ii) above is available.
(b) An applicant who is eligible under (ii) above could be considered for appointment only if no applicant/s qualified under (i) above is available.

B. MANAGEMENT ASSISTANT GR III (BOOK KEEPING)

Qualifications:

01. Should have passed the G.C.E. (O/L) Examination in six (06) subjects at one sitting with credit passes in:-
i. Sinhala Language / Tamil Language
ii. English Language / English Literature
iii. Mathematics
AND

02. Should have passed in all subjects at G.C.E. (A/L) Examination (except the Common General Papers) at one sitting.

Note: Preference will be given to those who possess the following;

- (a) An acceptable qualification in computer applications of not less than six (06) months duration obtained from a recognized institute.
AND

- (b) Two years of experience in the use of computer application packages.

Post Specific Qualifications:

- (a) The National Certificate for Accounting Technicians of the Sri Lanka Technical College / College of Technology under the Ministry of Skills Development and Vocational Training or any other equivalent qualification obtained from a recognized Institute.
OR
(b) G.C.E. (Advanced Level) qualification should be in the Commerce Stream.

Age: Not less than 18 years and not more than 30 years of age on the closing date of the applications

Selection: By written Examination & Interview

Salary Scale: UMN I (III A) Rs. 30,725 – 17x300 – 35,825/= (p.m)

BENEFITS:

01. Selected candidates will begin to contribute to the Universities Provident Fund by means of monthly deductions from his/ her salary and amount equal to ten (10%) percent of his/ her basic salary. The University will, in addition out of its funds contribute at the same time a sum equal to seven (07%) percent of his/ her earnings to the Universities Provident Fund and eight (08%) percent of his/ her earnings to the Pension Fund.
02. Three (03%) per centum of his/ her basic salary will be contributed by the University to the Employees Trust Fund in terms of Provision of the Employees Trust Fund.
03. In addition to the above salary, Cost of Living Allowance and other allowances approved by the University Grants Commission will also be paid to the staff where relevant.
