03. The officer should be conversant with conducting risk assessments, hazard assessments, HAZOP studies, environmental studies, incident investigations, root cause analysis etc.
04. The officer should be able to prepare disaster management plans, Oil spill response plans emergency response plans etc.
05. The officer should be able to prepare the annual budget estimates and control quality assurance procedures and should have a fair experience in participating in committee meetings and coordinating with the Heads of Function and outside organizations.
