BASIC QUALIFICATIONS

- Citizenship : Male citizen of Sri Lanka.
- Age : Should not be less than 18 years and not more than 24 years as at 30 June 2022.
- Height : Not less than 5' 6" (167.5cm)
- Weight : Not less than 52 kg (118 lbs)
- Chest : Not less than 32"
- Visual Acuity : 6/6 (without spectacle and lenses)
- Body Mass Index : Between 18.5 Kg/m² - 25 kg/m²
- Marital Status : Unmarried.

EDUCATIONAL QUALIFICATIONS

- Should have possess with three (03) Simple Passes at G.C.E (A/L) Examination and obtain 30% marks for the Common General Test in One (01) sitting and not more than three (03) attempts. Those who have sat for G.C.E.(A/L) examination in the year 2021 and are awaiting the results can also apply on the basis of the above qualifications.

And

- Passed minimum of Eight (08) subjects with Five (05) Credit Passes in one sitting and not more than Two (02) attempts and compulsory Credit passes for Sinhala or Tamil, English and Mathematics at G.C.E (O/L) Examination. The candidates who have obtained a Simple Pass (S) for English at G.C.E (O/L) will be considered if they possess Credit Pass (C) for English subject at G.C.E (A/L) examination or possess any NVQ Level - 4 or above Diploma/Degree in English medium offered by a UGC recognized university/institute (NVQ level certificate must be produced).

Or

- An equivalent result obtained at an internationally recognized examination (such as Pearson/Edexcel, GCSE, GCE and Cambridge) may also be considered with the recognition of the Department of Examination, Sri Lanka as equivalents to G.C.E (O/L) and G.C.E (A/L) (including the compulsory subjects).

OTHER QUALIFICATIONS

- Sports and any other achievement in international and national level and proficiency in other languages (other than Sinhala & English) will be considered as an added qualification.

PAY, ALLOWANCES & OTHER BENEFITS

- Monthly pay of Officer Cadet (Including allowances) Rs. 41,705.00.
- Officer Cadets will be entitled to fringe benefits, covering expenses for transport, uniforms, medical and accommodation.
- Those who successfully complete the Officer Cadet Course will be commissioned in the rank of Second Lieutenant.
- They will also receive opportunities of serving in United Nation Peacekeeping Missions and to follow local and foreign courses.
